


Knöll & Vogel Viticulture Preserving the flair of a family manor



Viticulture is a challenging task, with a tradition, to which our family dedicates itself both enthusiastically whilst respecting nature. Bad Bergzabern, located in one of Germany's most sun-blessed landscapes, offers the best conditions: Ideal climate, well-grown vines in the best vineyards and fun-loving people who love their home.

An inspiring sense of togetherness, family flair and a knack for combining traditional values with modern ideas come together to define the style of our viticulture. Three generations work hand in hand on 56 hectares of land with the intention of producing wines of the highest quality, each boasting an individual charm, just for you. Our vines grow in the best vineyards on limestone and decalcified loess soil. We constantly inspect the rows of vines to identify what the next step in the procedure should be. Our ideal: To harvest ripe and healthy grapes.

Respect plays an important role in the cellar– respect for the gifts provided by nature. Preserving quality in the cellar is the rule of thumb. With constantly updated specialist knowledge, empathy and vision.

Tradition comes into play with the process variants: Full-bodied red wines are wood-matured, white wines are in stainless steel tanks to preserve their fine flavours and the exquisite nuances of fruit. Classic varieties of vines such as Riesling, Dornfelder and Burgunder grow on cultivable acreage of over 50%.

As we always like to know where we stand, we regularly take part in wine competitions. This helps us develop our produce further and provides impetus to make new discoveries. It also helps provide you with a guide to your purchase.

At Federal state level, we regularly put our produce forward for consideration at the annual Rhineland-Palatinate Chamber of Agriculture competition for Wine and Sparkling Wine. In the past 3 years alone, over 100 of our wines have been awarded with various prizes. In 2009 we received 9 golden, 28 silver and 17 bronze medals of the Chamber of Agriculture.

The National German Wines Award is the most ambitious national competition for wines and sparkling wines. Our work has been recognised several times with the award of the golden and silver DLG prizes. We can also lay claim to success at "Mundus Vini" – the great international wine prize – where our wines have been awarded several medals.
